Her beloved property "Out Yenna" is now open for a tour. You are escorted through her magnificent home and are able to view Ric and Colleen's priceless collection of artifacts gathered on their travels all over the world. You will see where her books were researched, and Norfolk Island pies made from local eggs and fruit in season. This is a glimpse into the life of a modern-day literary icon. Welcome to Fitzzy's Farm, Norfolk Island's first-ever Lavender Farm! We join this exciting and informative tour and hear of the journey and challenges in setting up this beautiful farm. The island's unique climate and soil conditions presented both opportunities and challenges for the farm. It took careful consideration to select the lavender varieties that would thrive and adapt farming practices accordingly. A highlight of the farm is the copper distilling equipment used for steam distillation of lavender to extract essential oils. During the tour, take an easy walk around the farm, accompanied by the owner who will provide you with detailed insights into the 15 different lavender varieties that have been planted. To make your experience even more delightful, you'll be treated to a Lavender & Blueberry gelato in a waffle cone. Late this afternoon watch the sun set from a stunning Cliff Top setting at 'Orn daa Cliff' on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline and enjoy a feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment.
