



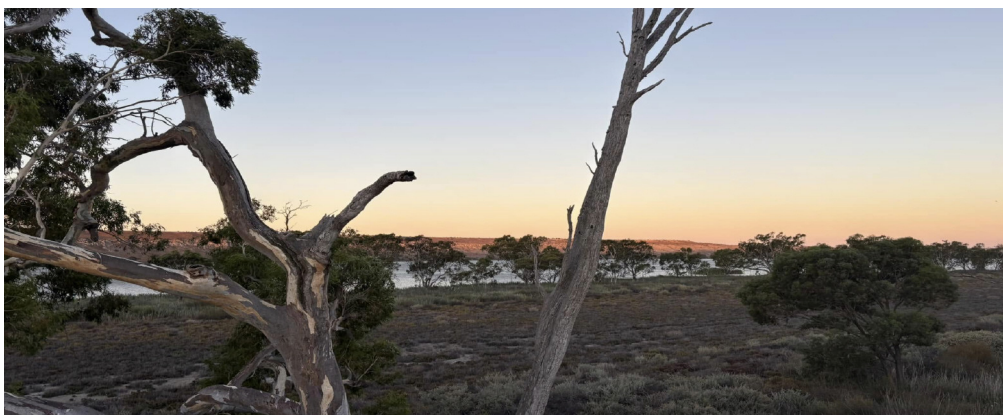

Day 1 – Sunday Depart Brisbane – Arrive Adelaide / Welcome Dinner [D]

Welcome to the start of your holiday exploring Adelaide & Kangaroo Island! We meet this morning at the Brisbane Domestic Airport for our departing flight with Qantas QF183 at 11:35am, arriving into Adelaide at 2:25pm local time. Upon arrival we will be greeted by our driver and taken to our hotel, Majestic Roof Garden Hotel. Later this evening, we will enjoy a 2-course welcome dinner at Culshaw's Restaurant, located at Majestic Roof Garden Hotel.

Day 2 – Monday Murray River Highlights [B, L, D]

Our Murray river Highlights totur today will see us travel to Mannum and board the Proud Mary, where we will relax as we cruise the historic river enjoying the wildlife and surrounding scenery. Over the 1.5 hour cruise we will enjoy a delicious 2-course lunch on board. We learn about the history of the river and gain an insight into the river's ecological system from informative commentary as we cruise. After disembarkation, we will take a photo stop at Mannum Lookout. We then travel back to Adelaide via the delightful Adelaide Hills, stopping at Woodside at Melba's Chocolate Factory, where we can purchase afternoon tea (own expense), or you may wish to make a shop visit to Woodside Cheese Wrights to pick up some souvenir treats to take home. We arrive back at the hotel with time to freshen up before dinner in-house this evening.

Day 3 – Tuesday Victor Harbour & McLaren Vale [B, L]

We depart this morning and take a scenic drive through some of Adelaide's southern metropolitan beaches, including Port Noarlunga and Moana before heading into the wine making region of McLaren Vale, best known for producing outstanding Shiraz. Visit a local winery and spend some time in McLaren Vale to discover the best of the town. From McLaren Vale we head to Victor Harbor, one of South Australia's most popular seaside towns, where you can take a ride on the Horse Drawn Tram over to Granite Island (own cost). Enjoy a 2-course lunch at Hotel Victor and some free time to walk the main street, then it's off to visit Horseshoe Bay and take in the spectacular views of South Australia's southern beaches before passing through the river township of Goolwa, where the mighty Murray meets the sea. Lastly, we continue onto the historical settlement of Strathalbyn, best known for its thriving arts community and antique stores. We later return to Adelaide, where dinner this evening is at leisure.

Day 4 – Wednesday Adelaide Highlights & Oval Tour [B, D]

This morning we board the coach for our Adelaide City Highlights tour. Our guide will introduce us to this delightful city, which is surrounded by parklands with a blend of historic buildings, wide streets, cafes and restaurants. Drive past Adelaide's cultural precinct - North Terrace, the National Wine Centre, Adelaide Botanic Gardens and the beautiful Botanic Park, home to Bicentennial Conservatory and the Adelaide Zoo. Continue through historic North Adelaide, where you'll see the tree lined streets, mansions and historic buildings. We stop and visit the iconic St Peter's Cathedral, then travel through the city's east on the way to Haigh's Chocolates Visitor Centre where you can purchase from the range of this famous South Australian chocolate. Alternatively, visit the National Wine Centre and take the self-guided tour of the Wine Discovery Journey Museum. There will be a stop in the city for lunch (own expense) before heading to Adelaide Oval, where we will join our tour guide for a behind the scenes tour. We access restricted areas and experience the thunderous roar of the crowd as we take to the ground through the interactive player's race. See where some of the worlds greatest bands have entertained sold-out crowds and step inside living history as you explore inside the iconic scoreboard. We return to the hotel late this afternoon and enjoy dinner in-house.

Day 5 – Thursday Barossa & Hahndorf [B, L, D]

Today we travel to the world-renowned Barossa, an incredible landscape of vineyards, boasting more than 160 vineyards and some of Australia's finest red wines. Visit a selection of wineries, to take part in either vineyard tours and/or structured wine tasting's. Tour through the quaint villages of Bethany, Tanunda, Lyndoch and Nuriootpa and stop at Mangler Hill Lookout for a picturesque view of the valley. Enjoy a delicious lunch, before travelling through the beautiful Adelaide Hills to Hahndorf, Australia's oldest German settlement. Here we will have free time to wander the main street filled with art and craft shops, German pubs, cafes and bakeries all selling locally produced food. Our afternoon concludes with a scenic drive to Mount Lofty Summit, Adelaide's highest peak. Take in the spectacular views of the city and the coastline - a perfect photo opportunity. We return to the hotel late this afternoon and enjoy dinner in-house.

Day 6 – Friday Kangaroo Island [B, L, D]

Early this morning we depart from our hotel for a scenic trip to Cape Jervis to connect with SeaLink's ferry for the 45-minute crossing to Kangaroo Island. Our first stop is Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery, an interesting bush engineered eucalyptus distillery that makes you the most of its environmental resources. Next is the Clifford's Honey Farm to enjoy an informative talk by the beekeeper followed by tasting's and an opportunity to sample homemade ice-cream. After a 2-course lunch, we head to the Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park to see and experience kangaroos, wallabies, emus and many other native animals up close. This evening we enjoy a 2-course dinner at Mercure Kangaroo Island.

Accommodation: Mercure Kangaroo Island (2 nights)

Day 7 – Saturday Kangaroo Island [B, L, D]

We commence our second day of touring with a visit to Seal Bay and walk along the beach with a National Parks Ranger amongst a breeding colony of wild and rare Australian Sea Lions. From Seal Bay we will visit Raptor Domain for the interactive Birds of Prey In-Flight Display, followed by a 2-course lunch. Later we head to Flinders Chase National Park. It is renowned as a sanctuary for native Australian animals including kangaroos, wallabies, koalas and echidnas. The tour of the park will take us to the rugged southern coastline for a walk on Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch. Remarkable Rocks provide great photographic opportunities and stunning sea views. Admiral Arch boardwalk takes you down a rugged cliff face to reveal this spectacular arch, a natural nursery and safe haven for playful Long-nosed Fur Seals that can be seen swimming and playing in the waves or resting on the rocks. Back at the hotel this evening, we enjoy our farewell 2-course dinner together.

Day 8 – Sunday Kangaroo Island / Adelaide / Depart Adelaide – Arrive Brisbane [B]

After breakfast this morning, we are picked up from the hotel and taken to Penneshaw for the ferry back to Cape Jervis.
