Day 1: Tuesday **Brisbane to Longreach** **(D)**

Welcome to the start of your holiday in Outback Queensland. A central meeting place in Redcliffe will be arranged for our coach transfer to Roma Street Railway Station to board the Spirit of the Outback, departing at 6:30pm for your overnight Rail Journey to Longreach.

Overnight: Spirit of the Outback (1 night)

Day 2: Wednesday **Longreach** **(B,D)**

Arrive in Longreach at 7:50pm for the start of your Longreach adventure. You will be met Longreach Railway Station and transferred to your Outback Pioneers 4-star heritage accommodation. In the early evening you will be welcomed by your Outback Pioneers host with a cuppa and home-baked biscuit.

Accommodation: The Staging Post, Longreach (5 nights)

Day 3: Thursday **Cobb & Co Stagecoach Experience / Starlight's Cruise Experience** **(B,MT,L,D)**

Climb aboard for your Cobb & Co Stagecoach Experience, including the stagecoach ride on the old Longreach to Windorah mail route, home-baked scones and tea, followed by a classic Australian movie. Enjoy a billy-can lunch while you watch the Old Time Tent Show. Afterwards, browse The Station Store outback emporium for gifts and souvenirs. At around 4:30pm, transfer to the Thomson River for Starlight's Cruise Experience. The cruise is followed by a hearty stockman's dinner around the campfire with bush poetry then the Starlight's Spectacular Sound & Light Picture Show.

Day 4: Friday **Nogo Station Experience / Qantas Founders Museum** **(B,L,D)**

We depart this morning for the Nogo Station Experience, which tours Longreach before heading out to the Kinnons' historic station. Our Kinnon host will take us on an insiders' journey of station life, including the merino story in the wool-sheds, Captain Starlight's stockyards and the station water run by open-top, double-decker bus to spot outback animals. Finish with a Saddlebag lunch and billy-tea around the gidgee campfire. Later, we transfer to the Qantas Founders Museum to discover the early history of flight and tour the Air Park. Later this afternoon relax at our accommodation before meeting at The Welcome Home restaurant for our Stonegrill Dining Experience.

Day 5: Saturday **Winton Discovery Day Tour** **(B,L,D)**

This morning we marvel at the magnificent ancient landscape enroute to Winton. Our day tour includes the award-winning Australian Age of Dinosaurs museum including the Dinosaur Canyon and the landmark Waltzing Matilda Centre. Enjoy lunch at the historic North Gregory Hotel and an afternoon of sights before heading back to Longreach. A hearty Country Classics dinner awaits at The Welcome Home restaurant.

Day 6: Sunday **Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame** **(B)**

It is a leisurely start with a gourmet breakfast in room this morning. Then we transfer to the Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame to explore the five galleries before lunch at the museum cafe (own cost). Relax in the afternoon and choose where to enjoy dinner for your last night in town.

Day 7: Monday **Depart Longreach / Arrive Brisbane** **(B)**

Following a leisurely breakfast, we check-out of the hotel and transfer to Longreach Airport for our afternoon flight back home. We arrive into Brisbane at 4:35pm this afternoon. After collecting our luggage, we meet our driver and board our coach for our transfer back to Redcliffe. It is here that we must say our goodbyes to our travelling friends, after a most wonderful adventure in Outback Queensland.
