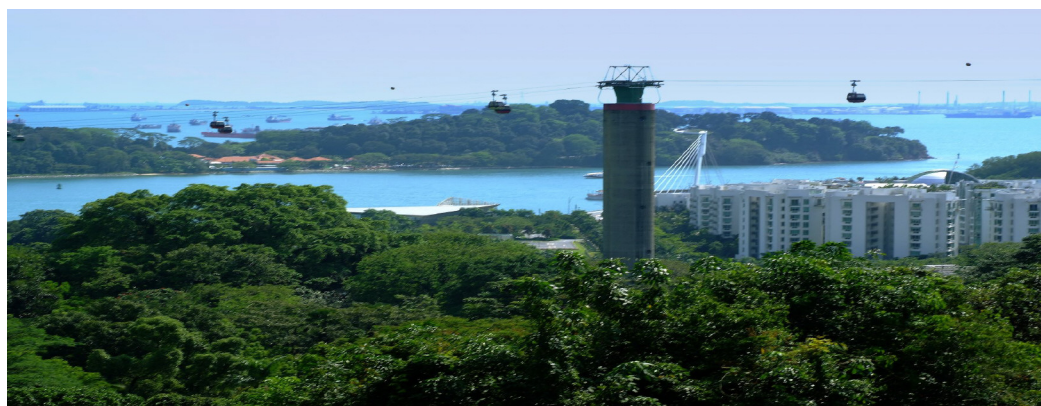

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Day 1	Monday	Depart Brisbane 09:20am - Arrive Singapore 3:30pm / Welcome Dinner	[D]
Welcome to the start of your wonderful Singapore holiday! Check in two hours prior at the Singapore Airlines check-in counter. On arrival at Singapore International Airport, we will be met by our local representative and depart for our stylish home for the next 8 nights. Tonight dinner is at our hotel. Accommodation: Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel, Singapore – 8 nights			
Day 2	Tuesday	Singapore Sightseeing Tour / National Orchid Garden / Bum Boat Ride / Dinner	[B/D]
Enjoy a delicious breakfast this morning before heading out to explore Singapore on a full day city sights tour. Singapore, officially the Republic of Singapore, is an island country off the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula. Prior to independence in 1965, Singapore was a vibrant trading port. Observe the rich cultural and historical heritage through the sights and sounds of the bustling ethnic enclaves. On the tour we visit the Singapore Botanic Gardens and National Orchid Garden. The Botanic Garden is a 156-year-old tropical garden located at the fringe of Singapore's main shopping belt. The National Orchid Garden is located on the highest hill in the Singapore Botanic Gardens, providing a place for 60,000 orchid plants - consisting of 1000 species and more than 2,000 hybrids - is the three hectares of carefully landscaped slopes. Later hop in one of the bumboats for a cruise along the Singapore River. These hardy little vessels have been in use from the 1600s in Europe, although the ones in Singapore have adapted design variations from the original European-style lighters. Commonly known as twakows and tongkangs in Singapore, they were once extensively used for transport purposes along the Singapore River. Tonight at our hotel, we enjoy a delicious dinner!			
Day 3	Wednesday	Cable Car / Sentosa / SEA Aquarium / Dinner at a local restaurant	[B/D]
After breakfast this morning we'll catch a cable car. Fly high above the hill from Faber Peak Singapore, through a skyscraper and cross the harbour before landing in Sentosa. Sentosa is an island resort off Singapore's southern coast, connected to the city by road, cable car, pedestrian boardwalk and monorail. We will also visit the magical SEA Aquarium with 100,000 creatures on view! This afternoon is at leisure. Tonight, dinner is at a local restaurant.			
Day 4	Thursday	Full Day Kranji & Changi Full Day Tour / Popiah Tour / Local Dinner	[B/L/D]
Departing the hotel, today we start the tour at the Kranji War Memorial commemorating heroes lost during World War II. Today you will see a Popiah (spring roll) making demonstration which combines food with fun, then wrap everything up with a touch of history because deep down, we're all cultured people. Popiah is an iconic Singapore street food that has been a local favourite throughout the generations. Although it looks similar to a wrap or burrito at first glance, Popiah is rolled up with a much thinner piece of dough skin that accentuates the flavours of its ingredients within. Next we depart for Changi where we will visit Changi Chapel and Museum: The Changi Chapel, situated within the open-air courtyard of the Museum, faithfully replicates the many chapels built during the Japanese Occupation. Built by Changi prison inmates, it stands as a tribute to those who maintained their faith and dignity during those dark years. As you tour the Changi Chapel and Museum, your guide will recount stories of the collective spirit that rose through the darkest times of World War II. Changi Village: A drive through the rustic and laid-back Changi village gives you a chance to see the relaxing side of Singapore. Lunch today will be at a local restaurant before transferring back to the hotel for some leisure time before dinner tonight.			
Day 5	Friday	Breakfast at the Zoo / Day at leisure	[B]
Breakfast is at the zoo this morning! The Singapore Zoo is the only place in the world where you can have breakfast with exotic animals! As you indulge in a hearty breakfast spread that includes international and local favourites, some special animals will make a spectacular entrance. Returning to the hotel the remainder of today and dinner tonight is own arrangements.			
Day 6	Saturday	Gardens by the Bay / Local Dinner	[B/D]
Today we will visit Gardens by the Bay. One of Singapore's premium tourist attractions this man-made garden is not to be missed when visiting Singapore. Garden's by the Bay spans 101 hectares and we will visit the following feature gardens; Flower Dome: The Flower Dome replicates the cool-dry climate of Mediterranean regions and houses a collection of plants from deserts all over the world. Cloud Forest: This 35-metre tall mountain showcases plant life from tropical highlands up to 2,000 meters above sea level. Dinner tonight will be at a local restaurant.			
Day 7	Sunday	At leisure / Raffles High Tea	[B/AT]
This morning is at leisure. This afternoon indulge in a luxurious High Tea experience in the restored Grand Lobby of the iconic Raffles Singapore. Amidst this elegant setting, savour finger sandwiches, house made scones and cakes and seasonal delicacies - all complemented by a curated collection of exquisite teas and champagne. The grandeur of floor-to-ceiling Victorian pillars, bathed in soft daylight streaming through the skylight...it is a truly refined and unique destination to celebrate Mother's Day today! Happy Mother's Day to all our mothers on the tour!			
Day 8	Monday	Marina Bay Sands / National Museum / Farewell Dinner & Concert	[B/D]
Today we'll visit Marina Bay Sands. Drink in the panoramic vistas of the stunning Marina Bay, the world-class cityscape, the architectural wonders of Supertree Grove and the vibrant colours of Gardens by the Bay. From Marina South Pier all the way out to the Singapore Strait, you will get a bird's eye view of the bustling shipping lanes that have built Singapore's rich multicultural history. We'll then visit the National Museum of Singapore with a history that dates back to 1849, when it was started as a section of a library at Singapore Institution and called the Raffles Library and Museum. The museum focuses on exhibits related to the history of Singapore. Tonight, farewell dinner shall be served at the hotel to mark the end of a fabulous week.			
Day 9	Tuesday	Depart Singapore for Brisbane 9:30pm	[B]
Today is at leisure for last-minute shopping or to enjoy the wonderful resort facilities. Tonight, transfer to the airport for our flight home. There will be option to hold your rooms until 6:00pm (See the booking form for details).
